Annually, the Intertribal Agriculture Council's (IAC) Technical Assistance Network hosts regional summits to provide accessible resources to American Indian and Alaska Native agricultural producers nationwide. Informed by the trade routes and food systems on this continent before colonization, IAC regional summits are open to Tribes and individual Tribal producers who want to learn more about agricultural trends, financial resources, natural resources, youth programs, access to USDA programs, and more.

Since its founding, IAC has actively supported the needs of Tribal producers nationwide by addressing historical inequities and advocating for inclusion in and improvement of the policies from which Tribal producers operate. IAC's programmatic offerings include technical assistance, natural resources management, domestic and international market access support, regenerative financing, and Native youth and young professional development.
